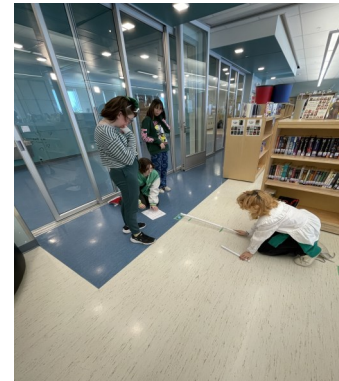




This month in the STEM Lab Grade 6, 7 and 8 students have been competing in the Science Buddies Ping Pong Challenge!

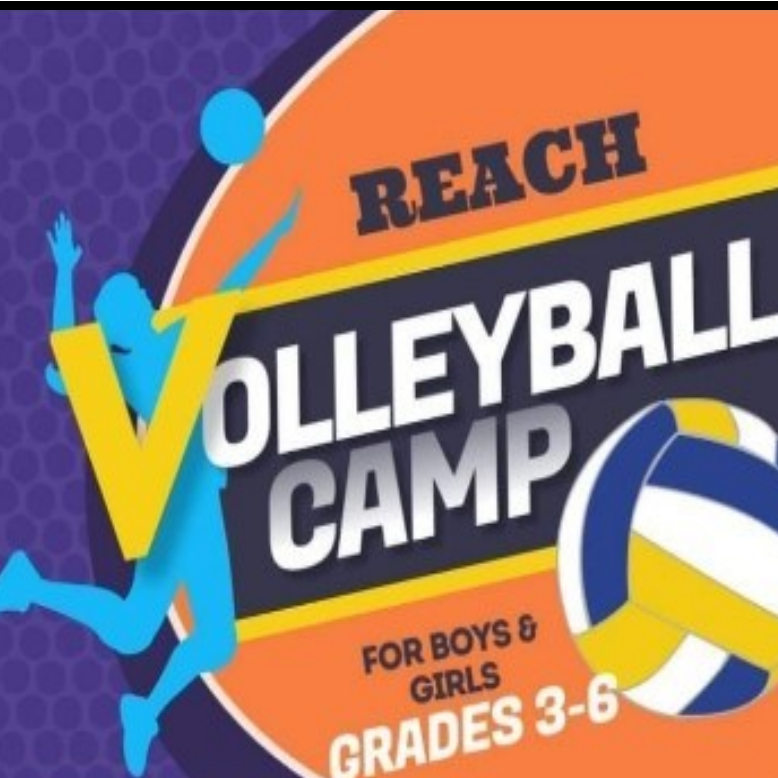

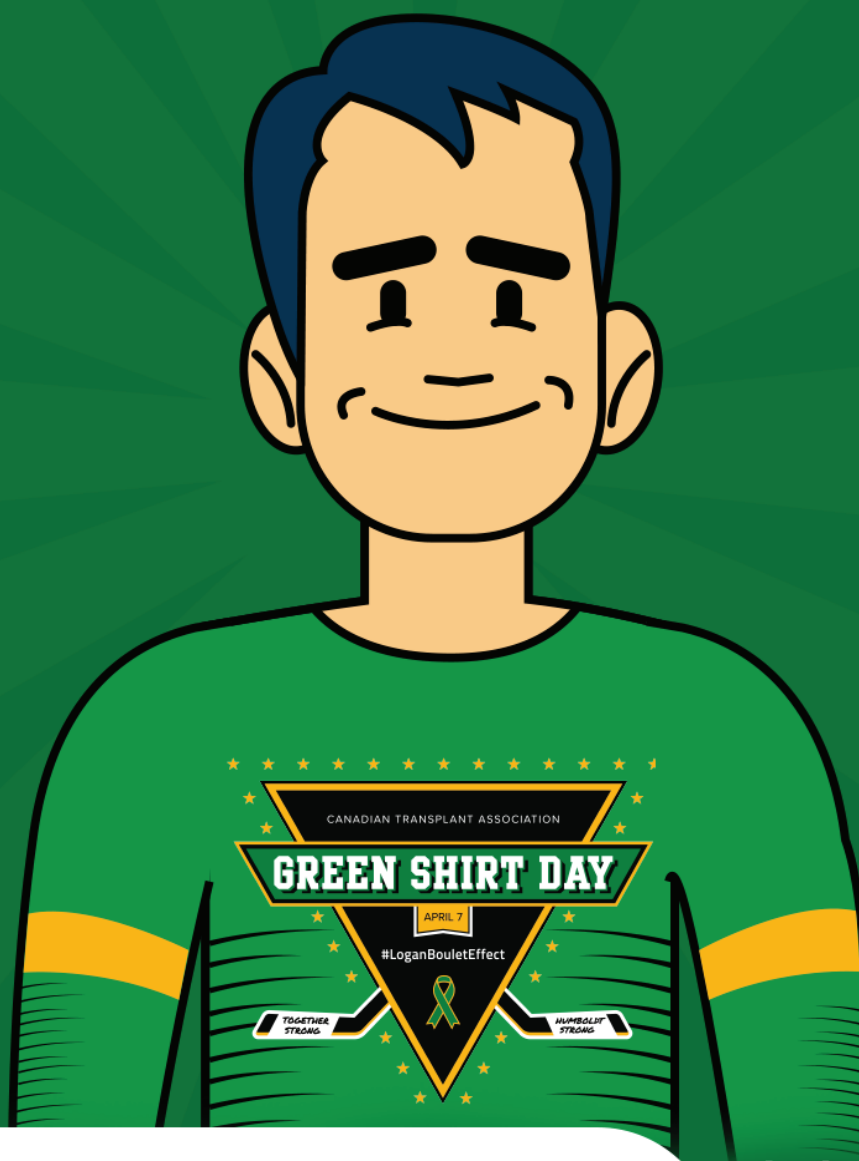
