- 1. School Council Position Elections:
  - a. Council Chair: Jen Bosch

- 2. Admin Report (Craig)
  - a. 612 students, small group of e-learners, 215 new grade 6s
  - NEW: 7 period day; literacy and numeracy embedded throughout other classes, each class is 7 minutes longer than last year plus a 10 minute break was added
  - c. Grade 6: 29-20 average class size
  - d. Grade 7: 29-30 average class size
  - e. Grade 8: 27 average class size
  - f. Microwaves- not for student use, not enough electrical capacity or time at lunch
  - g. Garage is complete and now full
- 3. Admin Report (Raj)
  - a. Personal device legislation implemented; devices must be kept in lockers. Students have adjusted well, staff pleased. Phones, tablets, smart watches and ear pods all included. Students can check device at locker during breaks or lunch. If devices are confiscated, they are kept in the office (haven't had to do yet).
