

School Bus Transportation:

Visitor Parking and Student Drop Off:

 Parents are asked to avoid dropping off children or parking in our bus zones during the times of 8:25-8:40am and 3:30-3:50pm. We have seven busses along with a complex learning bus, and we require all the space in front of our school. We appreciate your cooperation.

Athletics:

- Middle School athletics consists of five major sports: Volleyball, Cross-Country Running, Basketball, Badminton, and Track and Field.
- All students at Senator Joyce Fairbairn have the opportunity to engage in our athletics program. Our vision at SJF is to ensure that our players develop a love for the game, improve their skill, and grow as a person.
